THUNDER / LIGHTNING / RAIN PROCEDURE

If you hear the air horn either because thunder, lightning has been spotted or it is raining hard enough to stop the games, the following is to take place.

- 1) One manager or coach from each team needs to report to the RHAA storage barn asap to get updates. **One manager or coach per team only.**
- All other players, managers, coaches, and spectators are to move to their cars as quickly as possible and stay there. Do not leave the complex! No one is to remain in the dugouts. If a players parent is not present, the player is to go to a car with another family or go to the RHAA storage barn to seek shelter.
- 3) After 30 minutes, the Board Member in Charge will tell the managers and/or coaches in the storage barn what will happen next. They will be told that the games will resume, that the games are cancelled (and when they will be made up), or they will be asked to wait a little bit longer.

*** If at any time you see lightning or hear thunder — no matter how far away — and the horn has not sounded, you should immediately go to your cars and have someone inform the Board Member in Charge so they can blow the horn. The People working in the main concession stand will know where to find the Board Member in Charge.
